#### **TOUR OF THE FALLS:**



The Victoria Falls is one of the 7 natural wonders of the world and is arguably the greatest waterfall in the world. David Livingstone was the first European to visit the Falls and named it after Queen Victoria. The local name is perhaps more descriptive - Mosi oa Tunya (meaning the Smoke that Thunders). This spectacle occurs when the tranquil expanse of the Zambezi River plunges over a chasm 1708 metres wide and 103 metres deep, creating a shower of spray and a deafening noise. When in full flood (February to May), 550 million

litres of water per minute, tumble over the Falls into a series of narrow gorges for approximately 8Km, offering some of the world's finest white water rafting. The tour lasts approximately 1 & half hours, guided by a courier through the Rainforest along a 1.7Km ramble. After a briefing and explanation of the Falls, the guide walks with the guests along the path, stopping at the numerous viewpoints to gaze at the Falls.

### **LADY LIVINGSTONE SUNSET CRUISE:**



**The Lady Livingstone** is a brand new boat, based on a private jetty off the David Livingstone Safari Lodge. She is a 144-seater, 3 deck river cruiser. The lower deck accommodates 92 clients, middle deck accommodates 40 clients and the upper exclusive deck accommodates 12 clients. The boat can cater for the individual travellers or groups and conferences alike. The boat is suitable for private functions and can be booked on an exclusive basis on request. The cruise takes place along the river boundary of the Mosi Oa Tunya National Park. The total cruise time is 2 ½ hours. From the boat, sightings of elephant, giraffe, buffalo and buck coming down to the river to drink are common. There are also abundant hippos, crocodiles and birdlife. The cruise includes a complimentary bar and freshly baked snacks. An experienced guide accompanies each cruise and has good knowledge on the wildlife and local history of the area.

### **Friday 11 May 2012**

After breakfast this morning you will be collected from the hotel and taken on a private full day tour starting with Robben Island in the morning and visiting Boulders Beach in the afternoon to see the penguins.

Depart from Cape Town's Victoria & Alfred Waterfront by ferry for a 25-minute trip across Table Bay to Robben Island (also called Seal Island), accompanied by your driver/guide.



This World Heritage Site is South Africa's most revered national monument, and was once a prison for some 450 years – for, at one time or another, convicts, slaves, exiled Eastern princes, lepers, the insane and political prisoners being punished for resisting oppressive rule.

Among its more famous inmates was 19th Century tribal chief, Makana, who lost his life attempting to escape by boat across the Bay, and South Africa's first democratically elected president, Nelson Mandela. He spent two decades of his life on the island, along with some 3,000 other political detainees, many of whom were icons of the resistance and became leaders of the new South Africa.

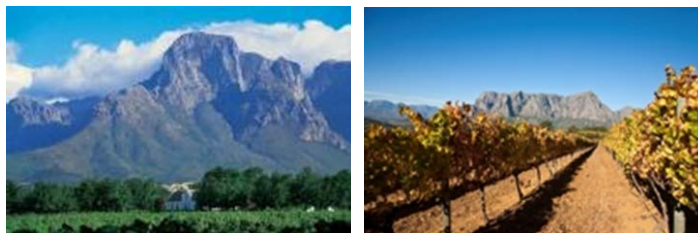
This stirring tour is led by experienced island guides (some of whom were once inmates) and includes a visit to the Prison Block and the infamous Limestone Quarry, where prisoners toiled, as well as a drive around the island with its breathtaking views across the bay.

Return by ferry to the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, and continue on by coach for the Boulders Beach Tour, stopping for lunch en route.

### **Saturday 12 May 2012**

Today you will be collected from the hotel and taken on a private full day Winelands tour inclusive of entrance fees and lunch.

Depart the city for the Winelands in the nearby Boland Mountains for a leisurely exploration of historic towns, liquid delights, gastronomic wonders and home-grown hospitality.



Wine estates visited will vary according to client preferences, but the tour generally includes the region's major wine producing areas of Stellenbosch, Paarl and Franschhoek, and there are chances aplenty en route for tastings of world-renowned reds and whites, as well as Cap Classiques – South Africa's answer to "Champagne". Lunch at one of the many classic, award-winning restaurants in the area.

Natural and historic heritage abounds in this area and your tour may take in sights like the Afrikaans Language Monument with its panoramic Boland views, the historic estate of Boschendal with its beautifully preserved Cape Dutch buildings and priceless period furniture, and idyllic Franschhoek, nestled in a valley settled by French Huguenots in 1688. Franschhoek is a delight for antique lovers and gastronomes (the town boasts some world-famous eateries).

Stellenbosch, South Africa's second-oldest town, provides another glimpse of classic 17<sup>th</sup>-century Cape style, with a chance to browse quaint Dorp Street and the many museums, galleries and shops of this lovely university town.

### **Sunday 13 May 2012**

After breakfast and check out you will be transferred to Cape Town International for onward connecting flights.
